Have a great half term everyone! Let's hope it's a sunny one!!

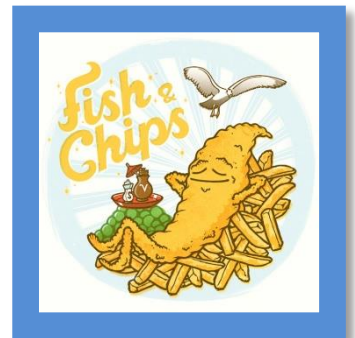
