Lockdown Drills

Over the course of the term we will be practicing a Lockdown Drill. This is standard practice in organisations, colleges and schools and is another strategy used to help keep the children safe.

The purpose of a school lockdown drill is to protect the children and adults in the building from a potential emergency such as the presence of a stranger or stray dog. Lockdown drills are different from evacuation drills. Evacuation drills are designed to prepare children, teachers, administrators, and other people in the school to leave the building quickly and in a preplanned and organized fashion in the event of danger such as gas leak, when conditions outside the building are safer than the conditions inside the building. In a lockdown drill, children are to go to the nearest available classroom. Please be rest assured that this is not happening in response to any recent concern or development in our school.
