
Happy Friday everyone!! We've made it to the end of week one of isolation.

These two fabulous pieces were sent in from Jenna, and strangely I think I saw the wolf in my garden that morning!




This acrostic poem was sent in by Jessica Sam, some absolutely beautiful language in here Jessica, well done!




Who are CAFOD?
