





Marvellous Mince Pies

- 1) Put the fluffy, white flour and soft, creamy butter into a large bowl.
- 2) Rub them together firmly using your fingers until they turn into crumbs.
- 3) Add the sweet sugar and the runny egg into the mixture and stir thoroughly.
- 4) Tip the mixture out onto a lightly floured surface and knead together until dough is formed.
- 5) Roll the pastry out until it is even and smooth.
- 6) Using something round, cut out circular bases and place them into muffin trays.
- 7) Scoop the mincemeat filling on top of each base, being careful not to overfill them.
- 8) Using egg to stick them together, place a pastry lid on top of the filling and gently squeeze the pies closed.
- 9) Bake in a pre-heated oven until golden brown.
