Whatsapp Groups

It is illegal in the UK to use Whatsapp unless you are 16 years old. There have been several issues that have come about from children using Whatsapp. Children in primary schools are mostly unable to use chat apps without becoming involved in issues that they



shouldn't, being privy to or participating in the writing and sending of hurtful messages, reading or using of bad and sexualised language, and arguments. Primary aged children have not got the level of maturity to deal with the fallout of chat apps and groups and online behaviour is causing some children a great deal of high anxiety. Children do not understand the far-reaching impact that messaging can have and how quickly content can be screen captured and shared on other apps. They have little understanding that everything on their phones is everlasting and once shared, they lose control over what they have written or shared. It is an increasingly worrying issue that we are addressing systematically in school. Please consider taking your child out of group chats as they appear to be doing more harm than good.
