

The Catholic Church Today

In January, the Catholic Church celebrates several special days and saints that remind us of how we can follow Jesus and live with love and kindness.

The Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus (January 3) – This day helps us remember how powerful and special the name of Jesus is. It reminds us to say His name with love and respect.

The Feast of the Epiphany (January 6th) – This is the day we celebrate when the three wise men (or Magi) visited Jesus and brought Him gifts. They followed the star to find

the newborn King. It's a reminder that Jesus came for everyone, no matter who they are.

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (January 9th) – On this day, we remember when Jesus was baptized by John in the River Jordan. It shows us how important baptism is for all of us to be close to God.

Saint Anthony of Egypt (January 17th) – Saint Anthony was one of the first people to live a life of prayer and solitude in the desert. He helps us remember the importance of spending time with God and finding peace in prayer.

Saint Francis de Sales (January 24th) – Saint Francis de Sales was a bishop and teacher. He is known for being gentle and kind to everyone. He teaches us how to be patient and loving in all we do.

Each of these days reminds us how we can live like Jesus, by showing love, kindness, and a heart full of prayer!
